- 12. matches
- 13. 5 yards of heavy cloth and thread
- 14. warm down jacket
- 15. Cooking pot and skillet
- 16. blanket
- 17. case of soda
- 18. iPhone
- 19. pencil and paper
- 20. 25 feet of rope
